Intervention for a Child with Unintelligible Speech

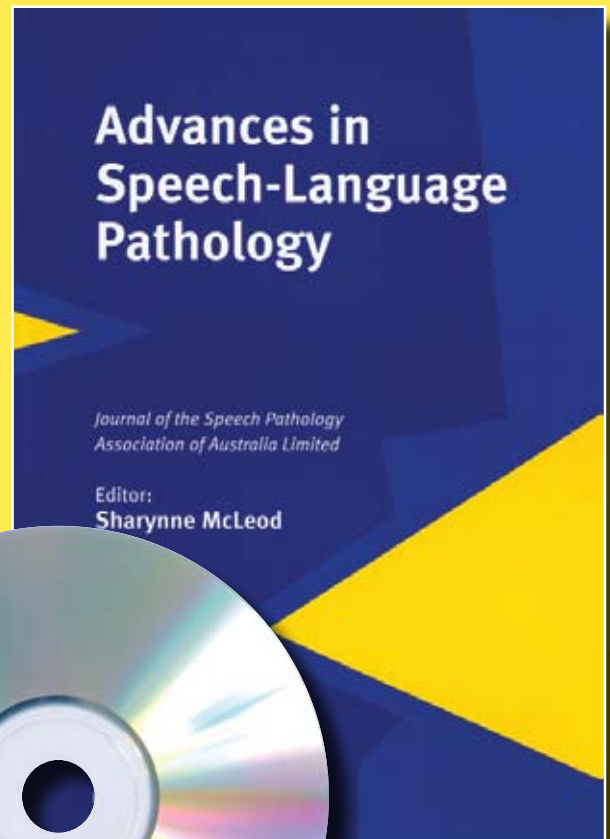
This special issue of *Advances in Speech-Language Pathology* is unique. Over 20 international experts in the field of child phonology considered the same 7 year old child with highly unintelligible speech and provided analyses and intervention goals for him.

The resulting papers within the special issue demonstrate that there are many possible approaches to working with this child.

For this special issue the child was assessed and videoed over three sessions and these videos, as well as background data, were sent to each expert.

Each international expert was asked to analyse material that they felt was appropriate to their intervention paradigm, to provide a description of their intervention approach and how it could be applied to this child.

The result is a fascinating special issue with supplementary video footage in the enclosed DVD which will help the reader see how the experts reached their decisions.



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
